Cllr Clare Potter	Heritage champion	This post has been long established, and is part of a Historic England (formerly English Heritage) national programme to champion the cause of heritage in the built environment.
Cllr Clare Potter	Fairtrade champion	The Fairtrade Champion chairs the Hackney Fairtrade Group which consists of representatives from the Council, local voluntary sector, education and local residents, and which oversaw Hackney's recent renewal of its Fairtrade status.

Cllr Yvonne Maxwell	Dementia champion	This Champion will serve on Hackney's Dementia Action Alliance which is the body aiming to secure Dementia Friendly Borough status for Hackney. The Champion will also engage with local voluntary and community sector groups with an interest in dementia, champion the needs of people living with dementia and their families and work with the Cabinet Member for Health, Social Care and Devolution on issues relating to dementia.

Cllr Sade Etti	No place for Hate champion	This post will support the work of the Council to promote community cohesion through building effective community relationships and contributing to the development of Hackney's hate crime strategy.
Cllr Sophie Conway	Care leavers champion	This post will champion opportunities and services for care leavers e.g. apprenticeships and work experience opportunities.
Cllr Mete Coban	Youth employability champion	This Champion will support young people in the borough and help put them in the best position to access high quality jobs or apprenticeships, and to pursue a variety of pathways including self-employment and careers in business.
