Woodberry Down is the Council's largest regeneration project. It is imperative that it remains on programme to deliver much needed new homes in the Borough. The Principal Development Agreement (PDA) negotiations took place over a number of months and were agreed in November 2014. It's now necessary to report to Cabinet urgently to make Cabinet Members aware of the revisions to the PDAs and the commitments made therein.
