Beis Malka - Proposal To Establish A Voluntary-Aided A School

The decision is urgent and cannot reasonably be deferred.

Consideration of the item cannot reasonably be deferred. The report is urgent and needs to be taken by the Corporate Director of Children & Young People On 7th August 2015.

The reason for urgency is that the decision as to whether Beis Malka is established as a voluntary aided school, the London Borough of Hackney is bound by statutory timeframes within which this decision must be made. Regulations stipulate that the Local Authority must reach a decision within a two-month period and in the case of Beis Malka's proposal, this is by **7** August 2015. Failing which the decision will be taken by the Schools Adjudicator.
