HOUSING ESTATE PARKING POLICY

This item was not shown on the Executive Meetings and Key Decisions Notice and pursuant to Regulation 10 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements (Meetings and Access to Information) England Regulations 2012 this report is submitted as a General Exception. The reason why compliance with Regulation 10 is impracticable is set out below.

This report is being submitted under general exception as it is urgent.

Reasons for urgency from the end of March 2016 Hackney Homes/Hackney Housing will, in partnership with the Council's Parking Services, be rolling out a major service improvement that will enable residents to purchase parking permits and visitor parking vouchers on-line. To be able to bring in this initiative the Parking policy needs to be approved as this policy sets down the framework and policy rules under which the purchasing of permits on-line will operate. Should the policy not be approved urgently it will delay the introduction of this important enhancement to the service offer to residents.
