5	Premises Licence: Round Chapel Arts Centre, 1d Glenarm Road E5 0LY	<p>The Licensing Sub-Committee, in considering this decision from the information presented to it within the report and at the hearing today, has determined that having regard to the promotion of all the licensing objectives:</p> <p>the application has been approved in accordance with the Council's licensing statement and the proposed conditions set out in paragraph 8.1 of the report, with the following amendments:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ The hours for all licensable activities, including the supply of alcohol, shall be:  Sunday – Thursday                      12:00 – 22:30 Friday – Saturday                        12:00 – 23:30</li><li>▪ Condition 9 – the first sentence to be deleted and replaced with the following - 'All licensable activities shall only take place during pre-booked or ticketed events'.</li><li>▪ Condition 21 – after the words "or other authorised officer" insert the following – "or any other person".</li></ul> <p>and the following additional conditions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ A maximum of 10 persons shall be permitted to smoke outside the premises at any one time.</li><li>▪ The Licensee shall ensure that all staff are fully trained and made aware of the legal requirement of businesses to comply with their duty of care as regards the disposal of waste produced from the business premises. The procedure for handling and preparing for disposal of the waste shall be in writing and displayed in a prominent place where it can be referred to at all times by staff.</li><li>▪ The Licensee shall ensure that any contract for general and recyclable waste disposal</li></ul>
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		<p>shall be appropriate in size to the amount of waste produced by the business. The Licensee shall maintain an adequate supply of waste receptacles provided by his registered waste carrier (refuse sacks or commercial waste bins) in order to ensure all refuse emanating from the business is always presented for collection by his waste carrier and shall not use any plain black or unidentifiable refuse sacks or any other unidentifiable or unmarked waste receptacles.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ The Licensee's premises are situated in an area within which refuse may only be left on the public highway during certain time bands. If the Licensee's waste carrier cannot or does not comply by collecting the refuse during the present or any future time bands imposed by the waste authority, the Licensee must remove the refuse from the public highway and/or keep it within the premises until such time as its waste carrier arrives to collect the refuse.</li> <li>▪ The Licensee shall erect a sign asking customers to refrain from littering the public highway outside the premises and will also instruct members of staff to make regular checks of the area immediately outside and within 10 metres either side of the premises and remove any litter, bottles and glasses emanating from the premises. The collection and removal of litter should include satisfactory disposal of spilled food and similar materials so as to leave the footway in a clean, safe and wholesome condition.</li> <li>▪ The Licensee shall provide a safe receptacle for cigarette ends to be placed outside, either on the wall or close to the wall of the building so as not to cause an obstruction or trip hazard, for the use of customers.</li> <li>▪ The licence holder shall maintain a dedicated telephone number of the Designated Premises Supervisor for use by any Responsible Authority or any person who may wish to make a complaint. This contact number shall be provided to the licensing authority, the police and to any local resident upon request.</li> <li>▪ All windows and doors shall remained closed at all times during whilst amplified music is played at the premises, except for the purposes of access and egress.</li> <li>▪ All music systems shall be routed through a sound limiting device. The limiting device(s)</li> </ul>

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		<p>should be set to a maximum level of 95 decibels.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ There shall be at least one person on duty when licensable activities are taking place to assist patrons leaving the premises quickly and quietly.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Reasons for the decision</u></b>                      The application has been approved, with the above amendments and additional conditions, as the Licensing Sub-Committee was satisfied that the licensing objectives would not be undermined.</p>
