These item were not shown on the Executive Meetings and Key Decisions Notice and pursuant to Regulation 10 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements (Meetings and Access to Information) England Regulations 2012 these reports are submitted as a General Exception. The reason why compliance with Regulation 10 is impracticable is set out below.

Growth Boroughs ESF (Unlocking Opportunities) Programme is being submitted under general exception as it is urgent

The reason for the general exception is that due to negotiations around conditions and definitions on the programme, the signing of the grant agreement has been delayed for a year and Hackney and its partners have been delivering the programme without payment and at risk. Any further delay will result in greater financial risk to all six partners. Secondly, in the immediate aftermath of BREXIT, the Treasury guaranteed replacement funding **only for** projects signed off **before** the Autumn Statement (23rd November).
