	<ul> <li>The Council has been notified by the Department for Communities and Local Government of a change to the Housing Revenue Account (HRA) subsidy determination for 2009/10 that has reduced the National Guideline Rent Increase.</li> </ul>		
	Not implementing this change would mean that Council tenants would be paying a higher level of rent than is now necessary.		
	Taking a decision now means that the Council will be able to ensure that the administration of this reduction can be passed on to tenants at the earliest opportunity.

### **Access and Information**

#### Location

Hackney Town Hall is on Mare Street, bordered by Wilton Way and Reading Lane, almost directly opposite The Ocean.

**Trains** – Hackney Central Station – Turn right on leaving the station, turn right again at the traffic lights into Mare Street, walk 200 metres and look for the Hackney Town Hall, almost next to The Empire immediately after Wilton Way.

**Buses** 30, 48, 55, 106, 236, 254, 277, 394, D6 and W15.

#### **Facilities**

There are public toilets available, with wheelchair access, on the ground floor of the Town Hall.

Induction loop facilities are available in Rooms 102 and the Council Chamber

Access for people with mobility difficulties can be obtained through the ramp on the side to the main Town Hall entrance.
