

Regulatory Committee

Regulatory Committee is responsible for the functions set out below.

- 1) The discharge of any non-executive functions assigned to it in the table of responsibility for local choice functions and responsibility for Council functions in part 3 of the Constitution.
- 2) The appointment of a Planning Sub-Committee, including approval of the terms of reference, procedures and protocols governing the consideration of planning applications.
- 3) All arrangements relating to Member training in codes of practice, procedures and protocols in respect of Planning Sub-committee.
- 4) Appointment of a Pensions Sub-Committee including approval of its terms of reference.
- 5) Appointment of such other Sub-Committees or other bodies, including their terms of reference, as the Committee deems from time to time appropriate.
- 6) The consideration of matters in relation to Part 1 Health and Safety at Work Act 1974, to the extent that those functions are discharged otherwise than in the Authority's capacity as an employer.
- 7) To receive performance monitoring information on matters within the remit of the Planning Sub-Committee and Pensions Sub-Committee. To monitor appeals made in respect of decisions of the Planning Sub-Committee.
- 8) Consideration and the submission of recommendations to other bodies of the Council on policy development and

responses to Government consultations within the remit of the Committee or its Sub-Committees.

- 9) To develop, review, monitor and maintain a strategic overview of the Council's regulatory function.
- 10) To maintain a strategic overview of Human Resources matters, including adopting any proposed changes to current policies which may affect the terms and conditions of staff employed by the Council.
