Subject:	Complaints Charter – agreement of charter design

Summary:	The 6 <sup>th</sup> September Board meeting agreed to adopt the Complaints Charter, which is supported by all the members of the Board. Also agreed was a public launch of the Charter so Hackney people are made aware of the aspirations the local health and social care bodies are committed to. It was agreed at the November Board to publicly launch at the next Board on the 10 January 2018. However this meeting was cancelled.
	In the intervening period it was recognised the design of the charter (as a poster and booklet) is important so it is accessible and fits into required standards (i.e. The Accessible Information Standards). Therefore at this meeting Members will be presented with poster and booklet options, which once the final version is agreed, will be printed following the meeting. The charter will be then be launched at the next Board meeting (likely to be June/July 2018).
	Draft posters and booklets will be presented at the Board meeting and are not attached to this report.
	The charter was created out of a Healthwatch Hackney NHS Community Voice public meeting on 'Complaining Effectively in the NHS' on 31 <sup>st</sup> January 2017, 85 people attended.
	At the meeting members of the public called for a local patient's charter on the rights of patients regarding the complaints processes, which all services and providers should sign up to and which treats complainants as valuable contributors to quality service delivery.
