3. BACKGROUND

3.1 Contract Standing Orders ("CSOs")

The CSOs at Appendix 1 have been amended from the previous version in order to provide clarity in certain areas, give greater responsibility to officers and to complement changes made to the Financial Scheme of Delegation. The revised CSOs will empower officers across the organisation to make contracting decisions at appropriate levels, streamline procurement processes and facilitate efficiencies.

The key principles of the CSOs remain. These principles are: to achieve value for money through appropriate market competition for contracting requirements in order that the Council can continue to secure Best Value services, goods and works for Hackney; to be transparent as to how public money is spent and demonstrate how it has been spent fairly and legally; to support sustainability and social value objectives and the public sector equalities duty.

A summary of the main changes to the CSOs is contained at Appendix 1.

3.2 Name Change for the Working in Hackney Scrutiny Commission

A name change for the Working in Hackney Scrutiny Commission to be called the **Skills**, **Economy and Growth Scrutiny Commission** and the remit to remain unchanged.
