AW replied on 14 Nov:

The cafe will run on the Pembury estate as part of the 10 year wider Children's Community Project. It provides an informal space for three hours on a Thursday evening (beginning mid- December), for young people to be able to access 1:1 clinical support, have informal conversations, and provide an open access referral site. It will also provide healthy drinks and snacks. Triaging is done based on the Lambeth tool. Longer term plans include developing and increasing the range of therapeutic sessions offered. Advertising plans to follow shortly.
