Dear all.

After discussions with the applicant and on the agreement of the below Police are removing their objections to the premises variation application for 31 Stoke Newington Road.

- The removal of off sales from the application

The addition of the following conditions

- 1) Save for a maximum of five smokers the use of the outdoor areas shall cease at 2100hours
- 2) There shall be no glass, drinks or open containers taken outside the premises after 2100hours.
- 3) There shall be no more than 30 patrons on site at any time
- 4) The premises in cooperation with and at the request of police facilitate a premises drug testing operation using the lon itemiser or similar device.

Condition 14 on the current licence to be reworded to read;

- (a) All patrons will be seated and be served by waiter or waitress service only
  - (b) There shall be no Dancing area for Dancing on the premises
  - (c) There shall be no Disc Jockeys on the premises
  - (d) There Shall be no standing at the bar
