An Integrated Care System for North East London - update

PURPOSE OF THE ITEM

To receive a verbal update from the MD of City and Hackney CCG on the accelerated plans for the Integrated Care System for North East London in the context of Covid-19.

OUTLINE

At its meeting on 12 February the Commission considered a detailed proposal on the plans for a single Integrated Care System for the 8 north east London boroughs which form the East London Health and Care System (the STP). Members discussed it with both Finance Directors from the CCG and the Council as well as the leadership of the CCG and the GP Confederation and a representative of the Local Medical Committee. The MD undertook to return with an update as follows:

ACTION:	MD of the CCG to bring a briefing on the constitution and
	governance of the new ICS for North East London and the
	implications for Hackney to the Commission at a date to be
	confirmed in summer 2020. This needs to take place before CCG
	Members cast a final vote on de-constituting the local CCG.

The Covid-19 situation has intervened in the interim and while it has delayed some of the constitutional actions it has also served as a catalyst for closer integration. The Chair has invited the CCG to provide an update.
