PURPOSE OF THE ITEM

To receive a verbal update from the MD of City and Hackney CCG on the accelerated plans for the Integrated Care System for North East London in the context of Covid-19.

OUTLINE

At its meeting on 12 February the Commission considered a detailed proposal on the plans for a single Integrated Care System for the 8 north east London boroughs which form the East London Health and Care System (the STP). Members discussed it with both Finance Directors from the CCG and the Council as well as the leadership of the CCG and the GP Confederation and a representative of the Local Medical Committee.
