Item 6 – Executive Response to LiH Scrutiny Review - Council and partnership response to escalation in serious violence review

Outline

The Living in Hackney Scrutiny Commission conducted a scrutiny review exploring a number of aspects relevant to an escalation in levels of serious violence. A spike in such crimes and a series of murders in 2018 was one driver for our review. We visited and worked very closely with the Integrated Gangs Unit (IGU) on this review.

In December the Commission published its <u>report of our review</u> on the work of the Community Safety partners in Hackney in tackling the spike in serious violence and in particular in violence related to gang activity.
