## 1. SUMMARY

1.1 The Environmental Protection have given the Licensing Authority and the premises user notice of objection to Temporary Event Notices for an event to be held on 24/09/2021 from 12:00 finishing on 26/09/2021 at 16:00 at above premises. The Licensing Authority must hold a hearing to decide whether or not to allow the event to proceed.

## 2. RECOMMENDATION

2.1 That the Licensing Sub-Committee consider the issuing of counter notices if it is satisfied that any of the licensing objectives would be undermined if the premises were to be used in accordance with the temporary event notice.

## 3. TEMPORARY EVENT NOTICES - BACKGROUND

3.1 Part 5 the Licensing Act 2003 permits small scale events to take place at which alcohol will be sold or other licensable activities will take place. The numbers attending the event must not exceed 499 people and there are restrictions on the number of events that can be held per year.
3.2 The individual must give notice of her/his intention to hold the event to the Licensing Authority, police and environmental health at least 10 working days (or 5 days in the event of a late notice) before the event is scheduled to take place by issuing a Temporary Event Notice (TEN). The event will be permitted to take place unless the Licensing Authority issues a counter notice.
3.3 The Licensing Authority can issue a counter notice if the number of permitted events has been exceeded or if, upon consideration of an 'objection notice' given by the police or those in the Council that exercise environmental health functions, it is satisfied that the event would undermine one or more of the licensing objectives.
> 3.4 If the police or those in the Council that exercise environmental health functions give an objection notice to the Licensing Authority, the Authority must convene a hearing to consider if it wishes to issue a counter notice. If the Authority determines to issue a counter notice it must give two copies to the premises user - a notice of its decision and a notice of the reasons for its decision. The decision must be made and the notices given at least 24 hours before the event is to begin. There is a right of appeal to the magistrates' court against the giving of a counter notice as a result of an objection notice

## 4. BACKGROUND

4.1 The premises are not licensed under Licensing Act 2003.
5. TEMPORARY EVENT NOTICE FOR EVENT TO BE HELD 24/09/2021 26/09/2021
5.1 A TEN has been submitted to allow licensable activities to take place on the premises. A copy of the Temporary Event Notice and additional information is attached as Appendix A.
5.2 The Environmental Protection have objected to the TEN on the grounds of the public nuisance. A copy of the Environmental Protection objection is attached as Appendix B.
6. HUMAN RIGHTS ACT 1998 IMPLICATIONS
6.1 There are implications for;

- Article 6 - Right to a fair hearing
- Article 14 - Not to discriminate
- Balancing; Article 1-Peaceful enjoyment of their possession (i.e. a licence is defined as being a possession) with Article 8 - Right of Privacy (i.e. respect private \& family life) to achieve a proportionate decision having regard to the protection of an individuals rights against the interests of the community at large.

## 8. CONCLUSION

Whilst Hackney Marshes has its own premises licence, we are applying for 2 separate TENs for our $x 2$ food and beverage ( $\mathrm{F} \& \mathrm{~B}$ ) areas within our event space, which will each serve a range of food and drink to both runners and spectators.

Each of these $2 x$ F\&B hubs will contain approximately 7 to 10 food traders and will take up a small print of around $50 \mathrm{~m} \times 6 \mathrm{~m}$ each.

There will also be 2 x bars (one in the north and one in the south) which are a very small part of our wider event and festival village, which contains all of the half marathon infrastructure, entertainment and participant facilities.

The Hackney Marshes is an area of common land on the bank of the river Lea, in Hackney Borough. It has been the location for our hackney half event village for the last seven years and continues to serve as the centre of activity for the 2021 event.

Please describe the nature of the event below. (Please read note 5)

The Hackney festival is an event centred around the hackney Half Marathon, returning for the eighth year in 2021. In addition to the half marathon there will be a community 5 k race, along with a multi-fitness stage area within our festival village. A range of participant and spectator facilities will comprise the 'race/festival village' including toilets, bag drop facilities, entertainment, seating areas and F\&B units.

The serving of alcoholic beverages will very much be incidental to the primary activities taking place in the marshes - ie the half marathon, 5 k run, the fitness classes and entertainment for all spectators of the main races.

Our traders will be operating a 'challenge 25 ' policy throughout the entirety of the event, and we will have visible security staff positioned at each of the bars.
