Insert Paragraph 4.1.1:

The published London Plan (2021) policies have not been significantly altered in their intention or wording, in comparison with the now superseded 2016 policies, with respect to their application to this proposed development

Paragraph 4.5, 4.5.1 - 4.5.3 - related to the emerging planning policy should be deleted as this is now referred to under 4.1, as noted above.

<u>Section 5.0 (Planning considerations):</u> where policies of the London Plan 2016, that are now superseded, are referenced through the report, these have been replaced with the updated and relevant policies of the London Plan 2021. For clarity:

Policy 3.18 is replaced with S3 Policy 7.8 is replaced with HC1 Policy 7.2 is replaced with D5 Policy 6.9 is replaced with T5 Policy 6.13 is replaced with T6 Policy 7.4 is replaced with D3 Policy 5.5 is replaced with SI 5 Policy 5.12 is replaced with SI 12 Policy 5.11 is replaced with G5

Paragraph 5.10.1 should state:

The proposal includes the erection of a new timber bin enclosure located on the boundary shared with no. 30 Ickburgh Road to create a more formal and contained storage space than the previous arrangement. The school will require 2x1100 litre containers (1 for recycling and the other for waste) with an additional 240 litre food waste bin.

The proposed location of the bin storage is acceptable and the space will be sufficient to contain the minimum number of bins.

Paragraph 7.1.8 (new condition)

The refuse and recycling storage facilities as shown on the plans (drawing no. 298-801 Rev A) hereby approved shall be implemented before the use is first commenced and retained thereafter.

REASON: To ensure that adequate provision for waste and recycling storage on site and in the interest of safeguarding highway amenity and safety.
