6. GUIDANCE CONSIDERATIONS

6.1 The Licensing Authority is required to have regard to any guidance issued by the Secretary of State under the Licensing Act 2003.

7. POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

- 7.1 Licensing Sub-Committee is required to have regard to the London Borough of Hackney's Statement of Licensing Policy ("the Policy") adopted by the Licensing Authority.
- 7.2 The Policy applies to applications where relevant representations have been made. With regard to this application, policies, LP1 (General Principles), LP2 (Licensing Objectives), LP3 (Core hours) and LP10(Special Policy areas Dalston and Shoreditch) are relevant.

8. OFFICER OBSERVATIONS

8.1 If the Sub-Committee is minded to approve the application, the following conditions should be applied the licence:

Conditions derived from Responsible Authority representations

- 1. A sound limiting device within the premises shall be installed to control all amplified sound levels in the ground floor. No additional sound generating equipment shall be used in the ground floor without being routed through the sound limiter device. The sound limiting device shall be approved by and set to the Council's satisfaction and thereafter maintained for the duration of use.
- 2. The lobbied doors at the entrance to the venue shall remained in the closed position when regulated entertainment is in operation, with the exception of the immediate ingress and egress of patrons.
- 3. The rear fire exit door shall remain closed when regulated entertainment is in operation, except in the case of an emergency.
- 4. The designated smoking area is located at the front of the premises facing on to Stoke Newington Road. The use of this area shall be limited to no more than 6 patrons at any one time.
- 5. Recorded music shall be played at such a level to ensure that noise nuisance is not caused to any un-associated neighbouring premises.
 - The provision of Live Music agreed to be removed from the application.

9. REASONS FOR OFFICER OBSERVATIONS

9.1 Conditions 1 to 5 are derived from the applicants agreement with the Environmental Protection team. The applicant has also agreed to remove the provision of Live music from the application.

10. LEGAL COMMENTS

- 10.1 The Council has a duty as a Licensing Authority under the Licensing Act 2003 to carry out its functions with a view to promoting the following 4 licensing objectives:
 - The Prevention of Crime and Disorder
 - Public Safety
 - Prevention of Public Nuisance
 - The Protection of Children from Harm
- 10.2 It should be noted that each of the licensing objectives have equal importance and are the only grounds upon which a relevant representation can be made and for which an application can be refused or terms and conditions attached to a licence.

11. HUMAN RIGHTS ACT 1998 IMPLICATIONS

- 11.1 There are implications to:
 - **Article 6** Right to a fair hearing
 - *Article 14* Not to discriminate
 - Balancing: **Article 1** Peaceful enjoyment of their possession (i.e. a licence is defined as being a possession) with **Article 8** Right of Privacy (i.e. respect private & family life) to achieve a proportionate decision having regard to the protection of an individuals rights against the interests of the community at large.

Representations (which include comments and/or objections) in relation to:

Police submit the following representations for the premises licence variation at 8 Stoke Newington Road.

This venue is situated on a busy main road with a mix of both residential and commercial premises. The venue is also situated within the Dalston Special policy area, the boundaries of which are defined in the London Borough of Hackneys statement of licensing Policy 2018-2023. This policy area was applied with the aim of managing the growth of licensed premises. The area has seen a rapid increase in the amount of licensed premises over the past few years and the footfall has increased alongside it, resulting in increasing incidents of alcohol related crime, ASB and disorder.

The applicant is seeking an extra hour on each which if granted that would allow for the supply of alcohol Sunday – Thursday until 0100hours and on Friday and Saturdays until 0300hours. The existing hours that the venue already benefit from exceed those core hours as laid out in LP3 of the statement of licensing policy

LP10 of LBH's Statement of Licensing policy states that any applicant will need to demonstrate that it will not add to the cumulative impact in the area. It is noted that despite being situated within the special policy area and seeking to extend hours further past the core hours the applicant has not made any reference to the policy nor have they provided any evidence or information detailing how they intend to operate without negatively adding to the cumulative impact.

The application also makes reference non standard hours on specific days but does not specify any hours for these dates. Police would ask that nonstandard hours are not granted for this licence and instead the applicant make use of temporary event notices so any events can be appropriately risk assessed.

It is of concern that should this variation for an extension of hours be granted it will undermine the licensing objectives namely crime and disorder and public nuisance

Annex 1 - Mandatory Conditions

Supply of Alcohol (On/Both)

- 1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence:
- (a) At a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence.
- (b)At a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
- 2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
- 3. (1) The responsible person must ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.
- (2) In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises -
- (a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to;
- (i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit(other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
- (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
- (b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;
- (c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;
- (d) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner.
- (e) dispensing alcohol directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).
- 4. The responsible person must ensure that free potable water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.
- 5.5.1. The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sales or supply of alcohol.

- 5.2 The designated premises supervisor in relation to the premises licences must ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy.
- 5.3. The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either:-
- (a) a holographic mark or
- (b) an ultraviolet feature
- 6. The responsible person must ensure that:
- a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures:
- beer or cider: 1/2 pint;
- gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25ml or 35ml; and
- still wine in a glass: 125ml; and
- b) these measures are displayed in a menu, price list or other printed material which is available to customers on the premises; and
- c) where a customer does not in relation to a sale of alcohol specify the quantity of alcohol to be sold, the customers is made aware that these measures are available.

Minimum Drinks Pricing

- 7. 7.1 A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.
- 7.2 For the purposes of the condition set out in paragraph 7.1 above -
- (a) "duty" is to be construed in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979;
- (b) "permitted price" is the price found by applying the formula P = D+(DxV) Where -
- (i)P is the permitted price,
- (ii)D is the rate of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol, and
- (iii)V is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the value added tax were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol:
- (c) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a premises licence -
- (i) the holder of the premises licence,
- (ii) the designated premises supervisor (if any) in respect of such a licence, or (iii) the personal licence holder who makes or authorises a supply of alcohol under such a licence:
- (d) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a club premises certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables the member or officer to prevent the supply in question; and

- (e) "value added tax" means value added tax charged in accordance with the Value Added Tax Act 1994.
- 7.3 Where the permitted price given by Paragraph 7.2(b) above would (apart from this paragraph) not be a whole number of pennies, the price given by that sub-paragraph shall be taken to be the price actually given by that sub-paragraph rounded up to the nearest penny.
- 7.4 (1) Sub-paragraph 7.4(2) below applies where the permitted price given by Paragraph 7.2(b) above on a day ("the first day") would be different from the permitted price on the next day ("the second day") as a result of a change to the rate of duty or value added tax.
- (2) The permitted price which would apply on the first day applies to sales or supplies of alcohol which take place before the expiry of the period of 14 days beginning on the second day.

Door Supervision

8. Each individual who is to carry out a security activity at the premises must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.

Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

- 9. The Licensee, the person in charge as a manger or supervisor in the premises, shall ensure that all times when the premises are for any licensable activity, there are sufficient competent staff on duty at the premises for the purpose of fulfilling the terms and conditions of the licence and for preventing crime and disorder. The Licensee shall ensure that all staff will undertake training in their responsibilities. Records will be kept of training and refresher training.
- 10. Any incidents of a criminal nature that may occur on the premises will be reported to the Police
- 11. Appropriate fire safety procedures are on place including fire extinguishers (foam, H2O and CO2) fire blanket, internally illuminated fi re exit signs, numerous smoke detectors and emergency lighting. All appliances are to be inspected annually.
- 12. All emergency exits shall be kept free from obstruction at all times.
- 13. All customers will be asked to leave quietly.
- 14. Clear and legible notices will be prominently displayed to remind customers to leave quietly and have regard to our neighbours.
- 15. The licensee and staff will ask persons who appear to be under the age of 21 for photographic ID such as proof of age cards, the Connexions Card and Citizen Card, photographic driving licence or passport, an official identity card issued by HM forces for by an EU country, bearing the photograph and date of bearer. The Challenge 21 logo and posters will be displayed at the premises.

- 16. All staff will be trained for Underage Sales Prevention regularly.
- 17. A register of refused sales shall be kept and maintained on the premises

Conditions derived from Responsible Authority representations

- 18. The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive CCTV system as per the minimum requirements of a Metropolitan Police Crime Prevention Officer. All entry and exit points will be covered enabling frontal identification of every person entering in any light condition. The CCTV system shall continually record whilst the premises is open for licensable activities and during all times when customers remain on the premises. All recordings shall be stored for a minimum period of 31 days with date and time stamping. Recordings shall be made available immediately upon the request of Police or authorised officer throughout the preceding 31 day period.
- 19. A staff member from the premises who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be on the premises at all times when the premises is open to the public. This staff member shall be able to show Police recent data or footage with the absolute minimum of delay when requested.
- 20. There shall be a personal licence holder on duty on the premises at all times when the premises are authorised to sell alcohol.
- 21. No noise shall emanate from the premises nor vibration be transmitted through the structure of the premises which gives rise to a nuisance.
- 22. There shall be no sales of alcohol for consumption off the premises.
- 23. Notices shall be prominently displayed at all exits requesting patrons to respect the needs of local residents and leave the area quietly.
- 24. There shall be no promotional sales of alcohol at the premises where alcohol is sold at a price lower than that at which the same or similar alcoholic drinks are sold, or usually sold, on the premises.
- 25. A proof of age scheme, such as Challenge 21, shall be operated at the premises where the only acceptable forms of identification are recognised photographic identification cards, such as a driving licence or passport.
- 26. An incident log shall be kept at the premises, and made available on request to an authorised officer of the City Council or the Police, which will record the following:
 - (a) all crimes reported to the venue
 - (b) all ejections of patrons
 - (c) any complaints received
 - (d) any incidents of disorder
 - (e) seizures of drugs or offensive weapons

- (f) any faults in the CCTV system or searching equipment or scanning equipment
- (g) any refusal of the sale of alcohol
- (h) any visit by a relevant authority or emergency service.
- 27. Premises to operate a zero tolerance policy to drugs and comply with the Hackney Police/Council Community Safety Unit Drugs and Weapons policy where appropriate.
- 28. The premises will display prominent signage by every entrance and exit explaining/re questing:
 - a. customers to leave the premises quietly and respect local residents.
 - b. CCTV in operation
 - c. Drugs policy
 - d. Weapons policy
- 29. Police and LBH contracted drugs dogs or drug detection equipment will be given immediate access to the premise s without notice for the purpose of detecting and reducing incidences of drug misuse.
- 30. An adequate and appropriate supply of first aid equipment and materials shall be available on the premises.
- 31. All staff shall be given refresher training every twelve months on the legislation relating to sales of alcohol to underage persons and drunken persons.
- 32. All staff shall be given refresher training every twelve months on how to deal with persons who are incapacitated due to drink or drugs.
- 33. The Licence Holder shall provide and maintain a dedicated telephone number of the Designated Premises Supervisor for use by any Responsible Authority or any person who may wish to make a complaint during the operation of the licence. This shall be provided to the Licensing Authority, Police and local Residents Associations. The Licence Holder shall ensure that any changes to these details are sent to these parties within seven days.
- 34. A fire risk assessment under the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005 should be carried out and recorded. Appropriate fire safety procedures shall be adhered to including fire extinguishers (H2O and CO2), internally illuminated fire exit signs, a smoke detector and emergency lighting.
- 35. All emergency exits will remain clearly marked at all times. Emergency escape routes will be kept free of obstruction at all times


- 36. There shall be no more than 50 people on the premises at any one time.
