1. INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE

1.1. Hackney Health and Wellbeing Board formally adopted a Health in All Policies (HiaP) approach in 2020 and refreshed its membership to reflect the contribution of wider partners in achieving its aims. This paper includes an update on HiaP strategies reviewed to date, and a draft forward plan for the Board to consider for upcoming Board meetings until March 2022.

2. RECOMMENDATIONS

2.1. The Health and Wellbeing Board are asked to:

ADVISE on any further thematic agenda items to include in the forward plan, related to the Health in all Policies meeting theme.

CONSIDER the HiaP work conducted by the Board to date and any process amendments/changes that could be refined for late 2021/early 2022's HiaP work.

3. HEALTH IN ALL POLICIES

- 3.1. A Health in all Policies approach is based on the recognition that our greatest health challenges cannot be resolved through the health and care system alone, but are highly complex and often linked through the social determinants of health. This approach:
 - systematically and explicitly incorporates health improvement and health equity objectives into decision-making across sectors and policy areas
 - aims to avoid harmful impacts of policies and improve population health and health equity
 - is about creating places which support and generate good health
 - is built on the principles of co-benefits: a healthier population, and greater health equity, brings longer-term social and economic benefits for the local community¹.
- 3.2. In July 2020, the Board agreed to:
 - Use the HWB forward plan as a framework for action to review policy and ensure that social, economic and cultural factors that influence health are systematically considered within all relevant local policy and strategy development.
 - Monitor the implementation of the policies to determine their impact on the health of the local population and vulnerable groups within this.
- 3.3. It was proposed that in order to adopt a HiaP approach, the Board would take a systematic approach to using each meeting to review a key local strategy/policy area, selected on the basis of its expected significant contribution to population health.

4. HEALTH IN ALL POLICIES FORWARD PLAN

- 4.1. A Health in all Policies forward plan was developed for the period of September 2020 to September 2021.
- 4.2. This plan focused on a different HiaP theme in each Health and Wellbeing Board meeting as part of the Board's work to refocus its purpose more explicitly towards tackling the wider determinants of health and ensure that wider health drivers are considered across all policies within the council, and across health systems.
- 4.3. Over the past year, the Board have reviewed strategies and had early discussions and input on the below topics:
 - Housing and Health
 - Growing up in Hackney: Child Friendly SPD
