C&H Covid vaccination uptake by dose



Snapshot of vaccination uptake by cohort and dose





Outreach – Q3 progress highlights



- 1. Improved uptake in a number of LSOAs with 1st dose uptake below C&H average of 65% for 16+ population
 - i. LSOAs under 50%
 - **5 of 13** LSOAs achieved 50%. A further 6 LSOAs are likely to achieve 50% in the next couple of weeks.
 - ii. LSOAs between 50-60%
 - **14 of the 25** LSOAs achieved 60%. There is still much more to do with the other 11 LSOAs which will need significant support from community organisations and engagement with ward members. Biggest increase in uptake observed is within Portsoken by 8%.
- 2. 1529 people vaccinated in Q3 within Outreach clinics. Main clinics include
 - 1158 vaccinated at Springhill Practice
 - 192 vaccinated at the Apex London Bridging Hotel
 - 171 vaccinated at Vi Forrester Kingsmead Pilot
 - 36 homeless vaccinated at Greenhouse practice
 - 42 vaccination at Mansion House
- 3. 8 grant funded community organisations were mobilised to support engagement and outreach clinics, and further funding secured to support 12-15 and 16-17 year old uptake

Outreach – What's next in Q4



1. Children and Young People

- 1. 16-17 yr olds: Education and pop up clinics within 6th forms and colleges. 4 initial pop ups being planned
- 2. 12-15 yr olds: Follow up visits to schools for 2nd doses, with family based clinics to be held on school sites after school hours that will vaccinate all ages 12+ up to 18. Currently engaging with schools. Grant funding secured for an additional 3 community based organisations.

2. Intensified focus with LSOAs with low uptake working closely with community orgs and ward members

3. Outreach clinics

- 1. Pop up at Liverpool St Station this Friday
- 2. Boots Liverpool Street agreed to weekly walkin vaccination clinics
- 3. Springhill clinics will continue throughout Jan
- 4. 2 clinics within the Biala synagogue to reach Orthodox Jewish communities
- 5. 2-3 clinics in Portsoken within the Guiness Trust estate (by end of Jan)

4. Health inclusion groups

- 1. 2 further vaccination clinics at Apex Bridging Hotel. All residents without vaccination status to be contacted and booked into either pharmacy/ Local Vaccination Site or outreach clinic
- 2. Regular outreach clinics at Greenhouse Practice and Church Walk for health inclusion groups
- 3. Further outreach clinics being planned with Find & Treat within homeless and IAC sites
