<b>Title</b>	<b>Summary</b>	<b>Decision</b>
<b>Family Hubs Bid</b>	<p>In November 2021, the Department for Education launched a new Family Hub funding programme. The funding was for between £650-£1m and required a commitment to the delivery of family hub(s) to 2024. The fund was to pay for the change process only, supporting Local Authorities who did not have hubs to move to a family hub model through programme and capital funding. Hackney Council expressed the wish to make a bid application in this regard. The bid required the approval of the Health and Wellbeing Board. Hackney Health and Wellbeing Board members approved this EOI via email in December 2021. (See the briefing attached)</p>	<p>The bid was approved by members of the Health and Wellbeing Board (December 2021)</p>
<b>Better Care Fund</b>	<p>On the 22 December 2021, the Group Directors for Adults and Public Health, the Better Care Fund Leads for London Borough of Hackney and the North East London CCG met with Mayor Glanville and Cllr Kennedy to sign off the Better Care Fund plan on behalf of the HWB, as required by national BCF Guidance.
