### 1. **Summary**

1.1. The Metropolitan Police and Environmental Protection have given the Licensing Authority and the premises user notice of objections to Temporary Event Notices for an event to be held on 28/08/2022 from 12:00 finishing on 28/08/2022 at 22:00 at above premises. The Licensing Authority must hold a hearing to decide whether or not to allow the event to proceed.

### 2. Current Status/History

2.1. The premises is licensed under the Licensing Act 2003 and the licence documents are attached as Appendices C1 and C2.

# 3. <u>TEMPORARY EVENT NOTICE FOR EVENT TO BE HELD 28/08/2022 - 28/08/2022</u>

3.1. A TEN has been submitted to allow licensable activities to take place on the premises. A copy of the Temporary Event Notice is attached as Appendix A.

### 4. Objections

4.1. The Metropolitan Police and Environmental Protection have objected to the TEN on the grounds of the prevention of crime and disorder, public safety and the prevention of public nuisance. A copy of the objections are attached as Appendices B1 and B2.

### 5. **Guidance Considerations**

5.1. That the Licensing Sub-Committee consider the issuing of counter notices if it is satisfied that any of the licensing objectives would be undermined if the premises were to be used in accordance with the temporary event notice.

### 6. **Policy Considerations**

- 6.1 When considering an objection to a TEN the Council will:
  - Expect that any existing conditions will be maintained (where relevant) in circumstances where an event is to take place at a premises that has an existing authorisation.
  - Assess any history of complaints as a result of licensable activity that may or may not have been authorised by a TEN.
  - Consider the track record of the premises user
- 6.2 Consider any other control measures proposed to mitigate the objection

### 7. Human Rights Act 1998 Implications

- 7.1. There are implications for;
  - Article 6 Right to a fair hearing
  - Article 14 Not to discriminate
  - Balancing; Article 1- Peaceful enjoyment of their possession (i.e. a licence is defined as being a possession) with Article 8 Right of Privacy (i.e. respect private & family life) to achieve a proportionate decision having regard to the protection of an individuals rights against the interests of the community at large.

### 8. Members; Decision Making

8.1. **Option 1** 

That the Licensing Authority decides not to give a counter notice.

8.2. **Option 2** 

That the Licensing Authority decides to give a counter notice, giving the reasons for the decision.

### 9. Conclusion

9.1. That Members decide whether or not to issue a counter notice for the event scheduled to take place on 28/08/2022 from 12:00 finishing on 28/08/2022 at 22:00 at location above.

### **Exhibition Of Films**

- 1. Admission of children (under 18) to the exhibition of any film must be restricted in accordance with: -
  - (a) Recommendations made by the film classification body where the film classification body is specified in the licence, or
  - (b) Recommendations made by the licensing authority where the film classification body is not specified in the licence, or the relevant licensing authority has not notified the holder of the licence that this subsection applies to the film in question.
  - "film classification body" means person('s) designated under s4 of the Video Recordings Act 1984(c.39).

### **Door Supervision**

2. Each individual who is to carry out a security activity at the premises must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.

### Conditions derived from operating schedule

- 3. All events to operate with the Operating Schedule submitted with the application.
- 4. All events that meet level 2 or above according to the Operating Schedule will be submitted via Hackney Events Action Team (HEAT) process.
- 5. All events assessed as level 2 or above according to the Operating Schedule will include SIA security staff and additional stewarding where necessary.
- 6. Where an event is likely to impact upon local residents or businesses as a result of increased noise levels, residents and local business are to be informed of the plans in advance of the event. Noise is to be kept to reasonable levels for such an event and reviewed regularly throughout.

### **Conditions derived from Responsible Authority representations**

- 7. The premises licence holder will provide police with a regularly updated schedule of Level 2 and 3 events taking place in Gillett Square and the event management made available to police or other authorised officer upon request.
- 8. A contact number should be available to police for the Licence Compliance Coordinator during all events.
- 9. Amplified music performances at Level 3 events will cease at 2200hrs to enable a quieter wind down period and slow close procedure.


- 10. There shall be a written dispersal policy. This policy shall be produced to police or other authorise officer upon request.
- 11. Where alcohol sales are authorised for an event through the granting of a Temporary Event Notice, the bar staff shall be suitably trained on the legislation relating to the sales of alcohol to underage persons and drunken persons. During these events a Challenge 25 policy shall operate.
- 12. There shall be clear signage requesting that people attending an event do not bring glass bottles into the event area. Any glass bottles etc found during the event shall be removed by staff/security.
- 13. SIA registered door supervisors shall be employed at the premises, on an ongoing risk assessment basis. All security staff and stewards shall be clearly identifiable at all times. All supervisors shall enter their full details in the premises daily register at the commencement of their work. They shall record their full name, home address and contact telephone number, their SIA registration number, and the time they commence and conclude working. If the supervisor was provided by an agency the name, registered business address and contact telephone number will also be recorded. This register will be made available to police or authorised officer immediately upon request.
- 14. An incident log shall be kept at the premises, and made available immediately to an authorised officer of the Hackney Borough Council or the Police, which will record the following:
  - a. all crimes reported to the venue
  - b. any complaints received
  - c. any incidents of disorder
  - d. any refusal of the sale of alcohol (when operating a Temporary Event Notice)
  - e. any visit by a relevant authority or emergency service.
- 15. Hackney Co-operative Developments (HCD) shall operate in accordance with the operating schedule submitted with the application. A copy of this should be kept on the premises with the Premises Licence and plan and produced to police or other authorised officer upon request.

### **Annex 1 - Mandatory Conditions**

- 1. Admission of children (under 18) to the exhibition of any film must be restricted in accordance with: -
  - (a) Recommendations made by the film classification body where the film classification body is specified in the licence, or
  - (b) Recommendations made by the licensing authority where the film classification body is not specified in the licence, or the relevant licensing authority has not notified the holder of the licence that this subsection applies to the film in question.

"film classification body" means person('s) designated under s4 of the Video Recordings Act 1984(c.39).

### Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

- The licensee will work closely with the local police, safer neighbourhoods team and LBH community safety officers and ensure there is adequate stewarding for all organised events in the square.
- 3. The square shall be well covered by CCTV and close links shall be maintained with the local Business Watch system
- 4. A dedicated administration office shall be maintained on site with all necessary facilities and equipment for meeting public safety requirements (e.g., telephone, fire blankets, fire extinguishers, first aid).
- 5. Trained personnel shall provide a full coverage to respond quickly and effectively to any community safety issues or emergencies
- 6. The licensee will work closely with the local safer neighbourhoods team, local neighbourhood and resident's associations and other outreach bodies dealing with anti-social behaviour.
- 7. Noise levels shall be carefully monitored and controlled to minimise disturbance to local residents.
- 8. All complaints shall be promptly attended to and followed up to prevent recurrence.
- 9. All staff shall be aware of child protection requirements and how to report concerns about the welfare of a child.
- 10. The Operating Schedule submitted to the Licensing Authority on 27 Sept ember 2006 shall be adhered to at all times.
