Good morning all,

As a result of objections by some Responsible Authorities to this premises licence application, I have discussed your concerns in detail with the applicants and they have agreed to follow your advice and guidance to ensure that the premises has a more robust operating schedule and operating hours more akin to the "Statement of Licensing Policy", this will ensure that the premises fully uphold the licensing objectives and operate with due diligence and consideration to the local community.

The premises will operate as a tasting room (Craft ale) with a counter for service, and the applicants now wish to formally amend the application as follows:

1. All alcohol sales to end at 2300 hrs
2. Regulated Entertainment will end at 2230 hrs
3. The use of the outside areas will cease at 2200 hrs
4. The service of food will end at 2230 hrs
5. The capacity for the use of the front area will be approx 15 persons.
6. The rear area will be approx. 40 persons, with a designated smoking area for approx. 10 persons

Food will generally be by means of pizzas being delivered by bicycle from a local establishment.

I would hope that these measures demonstrate the commitment of the applicants to work with all Responsible Authorities and to follow their advice, and that you could now agree to withdrawing your objections to this application; thereby dispensing with a public hearing.
