<p><b>OUTLINE</b></p> <p>On 9 Jan 2023 the SoS for Health allocated an additional £200m discharge fund to Integrated Care Systems nationally. This was publicised as the NHS purchasing additional social care beds. This is on top of a November announcement of what is normally called ‘winter pressures’ funding.</p> <p>Delayed discharges of care continue to be a key pressure on the local system.
