OUTLINE

Hackney's Health and Wellbeing Board has a duty to produce a health and wellbeing strategy which sets out the health and wellbeing priorities for the borough over a 4 year period. At its meeting on 9 Dec 2021 this Commission considered the draft Strategy and the consultation plan. The Chair asked officers to return a year after publication to update on outcomes.
