1. **Summary**

1.1. The Metropolitan Police have given the Licensing Authority and the premises user notice of objection to Temporary Event Notice for an event to be held on **06/04/2023** from **19:00** finishing on **07/04/2023** at **04:00am** at above premises. The Licensing Authority must hold a hearing to decide whether or not to allow the event to proceed.

2. Current Status/History

2.1. The premises is not licensed under the Licensing Act 2003.

3. TEMPORARY EVENT NOTICE FOR EVENT TO BE HELD 06/04/2023 - 07/04/2023

3.1. A TEN has been submitted to allow licensable activities to take place on the premises. A copy of the Temporary Event Notice is attached as Appendix A.

4. Objections

4.1. The Metropolitan Police have objected to the TEN on the grounds of the prevention of crime and disorder, public safety and the prevention of public nuisance. A copy of the objection is attached as Appendix B.

5. **Guidance Considerations**

5.1. That the Licensing Sub-Committee consider the issuing of counter notices if it is satisfied that any of the licensing objectives would be undermined if the premises were to be used in accordance with the temporary event notice.

6. **Policy Considerations**

- 6.1 When considering an objection to a TEN the Council will:
 - Expect that any existing conditions will be maintained (where relevant) in circumstances where an event is to take place at a premises that has an existing authorisation.
 - Assess any history of complaints as a result of licensable activity that may or may not have been authorised by a TEN.
 - Consider the track record of the premises user 6.2 Consider any other control measures proposed to mitigate the objection

7. Human Rights Act 1998 Implications

7.1. There are implications for;

- **Article 6** Right to a fair hearing
- Article 14 Not to discriminate
- Balancing; Article 1- Peaceful enjoyment of their possession (i.e. a licence is defined as being a possession) with Article 8 Right of Privacy (i.e. respect private & family life) to achieve a proportionate decision having regard to the protection of an individuals rights against the interests of the community at large.

8. Members; Decision Making

8.1. **Option 1**

That the Licensing Authority decides not to give a counter notice.

8.2. **Option 2**

That the Licensing Authority decides to give a counter notice, giving the reasons for the decision.

9. Conclusion

9.1. That Members decide whether or not to issue a counter notice for the event scheduled to take place on **06/04/2023** from **19:00** finishing on **07/04/2023** at **04:00am** at location **above**.
