Item 4 – Meeting the Council's Net Zero Target: Retrofitting

Outline

The Living in Hackney Scrutiny Commission is keen to hear about the progress made in retrofitting and promoting better energy use across Council-owned and managed housing stock, and in encouraging retrofit and energy monitoring across Housing Association, Private Rented Sector and owner-occupier housing stock.

The Commission sees this discussion as timely given the adoption of Hackney's <u>Climate Action Plan</u> in May 2023, in which retrofit is identified as a key priority.

The Commission is also keen to follow up on its previous work on retrofit and review progress against the Council's objectives since. The Commission last looked at retrofit at its meetings on 8th November 2021 and 12th December 2021, as part of the Scrutiny Panel's overarching Net Zero Review.

Particular focus will be given to progress against retrofitting and promoting better energy use across two key areas:

- Council housing stock
- Housing association, private rented sector and owner-occupier housing stock
